Admissions Scores of HKDSE Applicants Admitted in 2016

The following table shows the upper quartile, median, lower quartile, and lowest scores of HKDSE applicants admitted to each programme based on the calculation of (i) best 5 HKDSE subjects in Category A or Category C, and (ii) 4 core subjects and best 2 elective subjects in Category A or Category C of HKDSE respectively. The main selection principle adopted by the corresponding programme is shaded in the following table. Please note that some programmes may have additional requirements (*e.g.* specific subject requirements, subject weightings, *etc.*) in the selection process which are not reflected here.

Selection Principles

After having fulfilled the University entrance requirements and programme entrance requirements, our 34 undergraduate programmes will adopt the following principles to consider your admission to HKU. For 'Best 5 subjects' principle being adopted, the combination of your best 5 subjects does NOT mean '4C + 1X'; instead, it can be '3C + 2X', or even '2C + 3X' (if you have taken more than 2 electives). This arrangement will certainly give you flexibility in making the best combination of scores out of your HKDSE results. The subjects below refer to Category A subjects and M1/M2 are excluded, unless otherwise specified.
