Master of Nursing (MNurs)

Applications are invited for admission in September 2019 to read for the Master of Nursing Programme.

The MNurs Programme offers a part-time study mode, which consists of six semesters over two academic years and a full-time study mode of one academic year.

Candidates are required to complete 3 compulsory core courses (18 credits), 3 track core courses (18 credits), 3 elective courses (18 credits) and a capstone experience which includes a Translational Nursing Research course (6 credits) and a Dissertation/Clinical Research Project* (9 credits), making a total of 69 credits.

* Clinical Research Project is available for specific study tracks only.

Entrance requirements:

To be eligible for admission to the curriculum leading to the degree of Master of Nursing, candidates shall:

- (a) comply with the [General Regulations](#);
- (b) comply with the Regulations for [Taught Postgraduate Curricula](#);
- (c) be a Registered Nurse holding a Bachelor's degree in nursing from this University, or from another university, or a comparable institution accepted for this purpose; and
- (d) satisfy the examiners in a qualifying examination if required.

An application for exemption from the above requirements shall be considered on a case by case basis.
